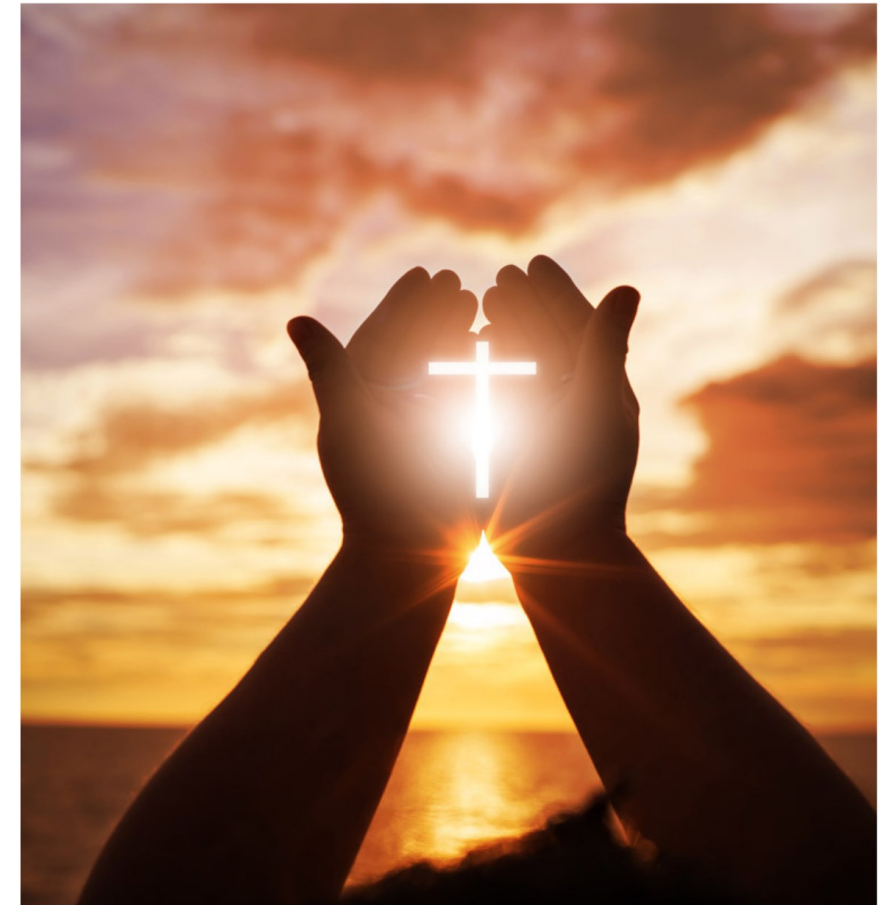

Every day we hear stories of violence in communities around the world, including our own. But there is another way to solve conflict, and it works. Learn about how nonviolence is being used globally - from Sunset Park in New York to South Sudan - to keep people safe when they are at risk of harm. This interactive gathering will help each of us explore how we can be a part of growing the use of nonviolence in our world.

Anna Zaros is the Director of Organizational Advancement at Nonviolent Peaceforce, an organization that works side by side with local communities to protect civilians in violent conflicts and build peace. Anna holds a Masters in International Peace Studies from the University of Notre Dame. She has worked to advance peace and justice for over 10 years, including in the Philippines, Bolivia, and across Minnesota.
