Reflection/Journaling Prompts

- When you hear the word justice, what comes to mind? What do you think about when you hear the phrase injustice?

- What does it mean to you to do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God in your everyday life?

- Where are places or the people in need of justice in the area where you live? (For example: poverty, homelessness, lack of affordable housing, immigration/refugees, racism/discrimination, human trafficking, violence, hunger and food insecurity.)

- What issues make you want to step in and help to make things right? In your journal, write those issues down, or draw something that symbolizes them. Then brainstorm ideas of what you can do. Ask the Spirit of God to show you how you can do justice, love mercy and walk humbly with God in these areas of injustice. Start with the easiest and then work towards something that will stretch you.

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
